STATEMENT ON GENETIC ABNORMALITIES

Animals which have parents or grandparents designated as carriers of a genetic abnormality are so noted with a line indicating such on the certificate itself.

The genetic abnormality is inherited as a simple recessive. Animals with a carrier parent have a 50% chance of being a carrier while animals with a carrier grandparent have 25% chance of being a carrier.

Genetically abnormal animals are produced only when carriers are mated. Careful selection of mates for animals with carriers in their pedigree is needed to avoid producing affected progeny.
