

HB Ranch

1612- “Daisy of HWF” Daisy is a nice dun 2yr old heifer that is open but she is ready to be bred. She is very calm, easy-going, leads well with the halter. She has a good body shape.

1613- “Amber of HWF” Amber is a very nice black heifer with excellent body shape. Very deep. She is halter broke, leads well and has good feet.

1614- “Diamond of HWF” Diamond is a nice 18 month old heifer. She has good feet and leads well.

1615- “Pearl of HWF” is a nice dun heifer, good body shape and feet. She is very easy-going & leads well. She is light dun, almost silver.

1616- “Bontrager Nelaine” Nelaine is a very nice heifer that is big for her age. Easy-going leads good. Her mom is one of our best cows. She is very nicely built with a very good structure. Her mom has excellent feet & udder.

1617- “Bontrager Rhoda” Rhoda is a very nice easy-going heifer that is only 14 months old but is a nice size for her age. Her mom had nice feet & udder. She is calm & leads well.

1618- “Bontrager Rosemary” Rosemary is a nice little heifer, her mom has excellent feet and udder. She is only 10 months old but she is developing well. Easy-going & leads well.

Cedar Ridge Farm

1619-“LSK Smokey Joe” is a gentle 12 month old bull. He will be broke to lead by sale date. His structure and growth are first rate. His pedigree is, likewise, outstanding. His genetics include the well-known breeding of Skye High Farms, Four Starr Highlands, and Osceola Highlands among others.. In short, Smokey Joe is a beautiful black bull with long hair and a pleasing personality.

Snowland Livestock

1620- “Snowland Riikka” Riikka is a 11-month-old red heifer. Her sire is Trafalgar James (D) #61370 a large frame red bull and her dam is Snowland W. Terry #53721, a successful milk producing 12-year-old red cow. Riikka’s vaccinations include Triple A HB, Brucellosis Calfhood Vaccination, BVD test and Ivermectin Dewormer. Riikka weighed 632# on 3/27/26. Her pedigrees include William Wallace of Dalriada, a national ranked RC Bull, Schon Boden, T2, We Tired and the national recognized Trafalgar genetics. Riikka has the potential to produce quality Highland cattle.

1621- “Snowland Risti” Risti is a hairy red 10-month-old heifer and halter broke. Her sire is Snowland Levi (D)#66166 a light red easy personality bull and dam is Snowland VT Sue #54718 a red 10-year-old shy cow. Risti’s vaccinations include Triple A -HB, Brucellosis Calfhood Vaccination, BVD test and Ivermectin Dewormer. Risti weighed 556# on 3/27/26. Her pedigrees include Trafalgar Luther, Twinflower, EZ Acres, Summit Ranch and Snowland First Lady and Snowland Peter. Risti has been friendly.

Dundonald Highlands

1622- “Magic of Dundonald” This fine highland bull typifies the 30yrs of selective breeding by Dundonald Highlands. Sired by Merlin’s Black Magic, a progeny of the outstanding LEA Raleigh. His dam is Leitis 13 of Dundonald. This line of "Leitis" brood cows were part of our original Highland cows forming the Dundonald fold. The long term breeding program placed a strong emphasis on good udder structure and ease of calving of brood cows. The bulls were selected from long established Highland pedigrees. This young bull shows strong resemblance to one of our greatest bulls, Jock of Dundonald. Hopefully he will likewise sire as many fine progeny.

LEA-White Farms

1623- “LEA Valli” Incredibly gentle heifer, just halter broke in less than 12 hours. Sweet disposition, comes by it naturally from her dam. This is a quality heifer to add to your breeding herd. Brucellosis vaccinated and good to go to western states, and has received Inforce 3, Bovi-Shield GOLD FP 5 L5 and Cavalry 9.

1624- “LEA Voulez-Vous” a quiet grand daughter of Sunset Rebel Yell this heifer should prove to be a potent addition to your herd. Her dam is an Impact dam and one of the top cows at LEA-White Farms. With a strong history of Impact dams, Elite Impact Dams and Impact sires in her pedigree she should make a good one. Brucellosis vaccinated, she qualifies for entry western states, and has received Inforce 3, Bovi-Shield GOLD FP 5 L5 and Cavalry 9.

LiTerra

1628- “LiTerra Redford” Friendly, fancy and frosted. This 7- month-old steer will make a good heifer or bull companion and will look stunning in your pasture. Gorgeous coloring, halter broken and likes to be brushed. AHCA Market Steer registration is in the works.

Keller Ranch

1629- “KFR Daisy” This pretty yearling red heifer, can be added to your herd! She has a feminine build and is structurally correct. She is from Silva's Swirly Spice and LEA Axel - both dam and sire carry some great genetics! She has been halter broke and is up-to-date on vaccinations.

1630- “LEA Axel” This gentle and easy-going white bull took care of business for us last breeding season. His calves averaged 58lbs and he sired 4 heifers and 2 bulls. Looking to sell him because our yearling bull is now ready to go and we do not have space for multiple bulls. Our loss is your gain.

1634- “Skye High Riona” Skye High Riona is a pretty headed straight lined female with a great disposition. No haircuts or fancy fees on this one. From a proven great uddered cow line going back to Cornerstone, Gusgurlach, GOF Claudette and others. She’s sired by a young up and coming red bull LEA Rourke who we admired for his soundness and collective look. Riona was successfully shown by our five year old daughter last year at the U.P. State Fair and couldn’t have been better for her.
