





Newspaper picture, from London dated June 19, 1898; featuring a young lad sleeping in the hay while his prize show cows await his attention.






Live 84 Vintage Borden's Elsie the Cow Drinking Glasses






Live 10Sweet Jersey Farm Catalog







Silent 7Jersey: The Preeminent Choice, Always


"This beautiful card is a print of the original watercolor painted by Michele Ackerman. The three cow heads in this piece were initially created as a tribute to the Equity program sponsored by National All-Jersey Inc. Just two prints to commemorate the leadership of Dr. Guy M. Crews were made with this image as a centerpiece in 2011. One was donated to the AJCC Research Foundation benefit auction (purchased by Hilmar Cheese); the other was retained by the artist. The three ladies represent changes in the look of the Jersey breed over a 70-year time period. The image on the left is from the 1940s, the center from the 1980s and the right, a modern-day image."
